## 2009 Late-Season e-Newsletter

### September Update

Despite the strong winds from both East and West in recent weeks, the fishing has improved on most lakes over the past weeks, though some trout are still proving hard to entice onto the fly. Some good results have been achieved by trying a selection of different flies. Daddies have been successful recently and are worth a try. Mike Rudd has recommenced re-stocking after the summer heat-pause. The lakes at Little Bognor are still fishing well but the others are more demanding.

Several people have tried fishing for Carp at Cox's and have caught some fine fish on both wet and dry flies. These have ranged from a piece of brown wool tied to a hook to a dry Bonio which is a floating grey ball with an orange tip. For those members who have not tried this exciting fishing, why not have a go as the Carp fight really well.
